REVERENT RAMBLINGS

THE JOURNEY

I'm now into the second semester of my first-year studies at Trinity Theological College. I returned from Thailand last July amid the pandemic. I am thankful to God for His grace all these years away from home. Coming back to Singapore with an almost empty airport and the empty airplane was the start of my journey adjusting to life back in Singapore.

There is a sense of familiarity yet unfamiliarity after being away for five years. There are more "colours" on the MRT map, and the circle line has become a legit circle. Empty lands are now occupied by HDBs and condos. People are walking at a faster pace. Crowds. Something seems to be out of place; perhaps I am out of place.

Shortly after arriving and completing my SHN, I plunged into the student life routine. My first semester was like me trying to learn surfing for the first time. Every time I try to stand on the surfboard to catch the wave, I would fall back into the water before I could even stand. I try again, and I would fall again. At times, I would be choked by the seawater that I accidentally gulped down. After many times of getting up, falling, and trying again. I was drained of all energy. But there were also moments I could stand and catch the wave, but it was only for a split second. This was how I felt.

I was reminded of the story of Peter in Matthew 14:22-33. When Peter saw Jesus walking on water, he wanted to go to Jesus. As Peter was walking to the Lord, he saw the wind and was afraid. Beginning to sink, he cried out to Jesus, and the Lord reached out his hand and took hold of him.

The Lord reminded me to fix my eyes upon Him and not on the "wind." Have you ever thought about how Peter could see the wind? We can all feel the wind, but I don't think we can see it. Peter began to drown

because of something he can't see. Fear overwhelmed Peter. When we focus on our fear, we are not trusting God. We doubt God. We see how scary the "wind" is but not how powerful our God is. The "wind" in my life is the unfamiliarity, uncertainties, the readings, and the essays. How about you? What is the "wind" in your life that prevents you from trusting in God? What are the fears in your life?

The other thing that struck me was when Peter was drowning, he cried out to Jesus. The next thing we know was that Jesus reached out his hands to Peter. Jesus held on to him. There were many times I, too, was "drowned" in my assignments and readings. I just couldn't do it with my own effort. I cried out to God, and He reached out His hands to me. Are you "drowning" in your problems, stress, uncertainties? Cry out to God. He will hear you.

I wouldn't say that I know how to "surf" through life already, but I am still on a journey. You, too, are on a journey. I pray that through our journey, we may fix our eyes on Jesus and be confident that whenever we cry out to Him, He will answer us. Of all the disciples on the boat, Peter was the only one who dared to step out to where Jesus was. Will you be like Peter, or will you remain in the boat? Let us keep our "eyes on the goal, where God is beckoning us onward - to Jesus." (Philippians 3:14)

Atlanta
