REVERENT RAMBLINGS

"It is finished"

It has always been a tradition to focus on the last seven words of Jesus Christ as He was crucified on the cross. It is not merely a conversation between Jesus and God or Jesus and his disciples. Each of the last seven words has a profound implication on how we live our present life, and one of the last seven words is "It is finished."

You have probably said the phrase "It is finished" umpteen times. It could be that you had graduated from University and thinking that this is the end of my study journey. I said it twice in relation to my studies. The first time was when I completed my degree in Accounting and my Master in Divinity course. It could be that you had retired from your full-time job and no more stress from the demanding job.

On the other hand, it could be something terrible. When I first saw my 'A' level results, even though I did not utter out, I was thinking aloud, "It is finished." In another instance was during my driving test when I hit the kerp of the road while doing parallel parking. My instant thought was, "It is finished."

When Jesus said, "It is finished," the equivalent Greek word is "it is accomplished," "it is fulfilled," or even "it is paid in full." So, what was accomplished, fulfilled, or paid in full? Before Jesus' death on the cross, sin was atoned through a system of animals' sacrifices. In a sense, the atonement for sins was never finished because the act of sacrifice had to be done repeatedly. However, when Jesus sacrificed Himself on the cross, men are reconciled back to God based on what Jesus did. Those who believe in Jesus' redemptive work will not perish but will have

eternal life. It was not possible before the death of Jesus until he finished doing the Will of his Father.

Jesus' fulfillment of his Father's Will in forgiving sinners should also bring about a transformation in our life. As Paul says in Colossians 3:13, "bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive." Often, you will find it difficult to forgive when someone has done you wrong. The pain that is inflicted upon you finds no outlet to be released. Based on our strength, forgiveness is hard to come by.

The key to forgiving others is to remember that you, too are the beneficiary of Jesus' finished work. Jesus' finished work is the mercy and grace extended to you for the debt you cannot pay. Having benefited from the goodness of God, do not withhold your forgiveness, but pass it on so that God's name will be glorified. A brother-in-Christ of WAC related that her daughter was involved in a serious road accident due to her friend's reckless driving. If not for the forgiveness of Christ, he could not bring himself to forgive the driver who had caused her daughter's injury and the trauma. Indeed, when Jesus said, "It is finished", we are set free from the bondage of sin, and our lives are changed.
