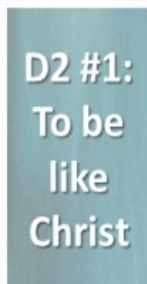
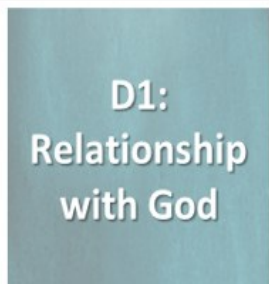

DEVOTION FOR THE WEEK

Do You Want to Be a Superhero?

A very blessed Father's Day to all fathers! To some of us, our fathers are like a superhero to us. They may not wear capes and fight crimes, but they possess superpowers in the form of helping us with our problems, the power to fix just about anything, and the ability to hold back their tears. On behalf of all children, we thank you for your stoic love for your children. We thank you for being the superhero in our lives!

When I was a kid, after watching many shows about superheroes and all the different powers they possessed, I wished that I had all kinds of superpowers. I thought to myself, wouldn't the world be a much better place if we all had certain abilities? We could use those power for good! Unfortunately, just like in the shows, people also do use power for evil, so maybe, just maybe, the current world is the best possible world that God could have made.

As I grew up, I've come to realise that the power of superpowers is not inherently found in what the ability can do, but rather what are the abilities used for. This means that we do not need to have superpowers to fulfil the role of a superhero, which is to help others! There is a saying, "Not all heroes wear capes". We don't need to be wearing a cape to use what we have to help others. We don't need to be wearing a cape to do good. As we have learned in the past few weeks of our Pulpit Discipleship, **the Holy Spirit is the one who empowers us to do good!**

1 Corinthians 12:7–11

[7] To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. [8] For to one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, [9] to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, [10] to another the working of

miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. [11] All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.

The Holy Spirit empowers us with different gifts, different “powers”, for different purposes, but ultimately, **“for the common good”**. No gift is better than the other, as we all need to work together with our different gifts for the greater good of the body of Christ. The gift of tongues would be meaningless if there was no one to interpret the meaning of what was said. **Our gifts are to be used for God’s work and to glorify God.** I would take the power of the Holy Spirit over any power that we see in movies any day!

Do you want to be a superhero? Look no further, we have the power from the Holy Spirit to do wonders and miracles for God’s purposes. We just need to be faithful with what we have, and God will multiply the effect of our works. May we look to God for strength and wisdom as we go about showing His love to the people around us!

ONLINE HOLY COMMUNION SERVICE

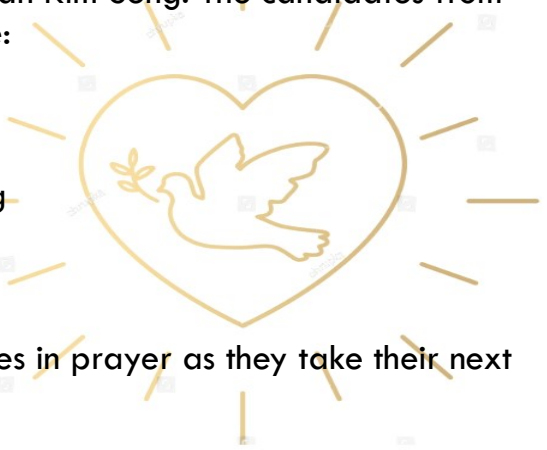
The online dispensation of Holy Communion will expire on June 30, 2022.
