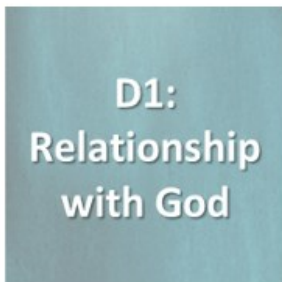

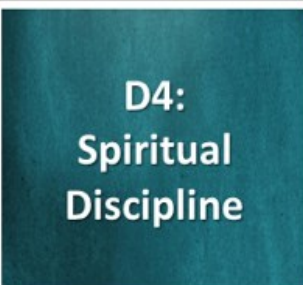
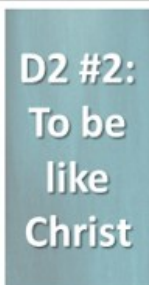

DEVOTION FOR THE WEEK

My Past 7 days...

[Joshua 10:29-11:15]

11:18 Joshua made war a long time with all those kings.

Dearest Brothers and Sisters,

Many years ago, Joshua fought a long and physical war. He conquered the lands “*from the Jordan to the Great Sea in the west*” (Joshua 23:4). The bible tells us that the war lasted for ‘a long time’ (Joshua 11:18). During this time, there were many setbacks. Some came from the enemies, while others actually came from within his own Israelite community (given his initial trepidation, these issues could have been much harder for Joshua to face). I’m sure there could have been many times when Joshua felt like giving up. Nonetheless, nearing his last days, Joshua continued to say “*But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD*” (Joshua 24:15).

There’s a war going on in the world – a spiritual war. Like it or not, each day is a war in our life, because “the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour” (1 Peter 5:8). We’re not fighting against people or situations. We’re fighting against the devil, who is constantly trying to strip us from walking in God’s grace and mercy, tempting us to do the things that displeases God, sowing discords and

negative core beliefs in our hearts and in our communities and households.

If you read Joshua 10:29-11:15, you will find a list of Joshua's conquests of the Southern and Northern Canaan, citing names of cities and kings. At every juncture, at every successful conquest, there is a platform for thanksgiving.

An ODB devotional author challenged his readers to "Think over what has happened in the past seven days. What can you thank God for?" Obediently, I started to make a list for each day that had passed. Just for illustration, I'm going to share a bit (just 3 days) of my list:

Sunday:

- Thank God for helping me through the sermon
- Thank God for bringing my mum to church
- Thank God for the unplanned but wonderful lunch time with church members, which also blessed my mum with fellowship she needed
- Thank God for a successful early celebration for my father-in-law
- Thank God for the dinner I finally managed to have with my cousins

Monday:

- Thank God for providing so that I can hire help for housework, and for much food in the house that were blessed by others.
- Thank God for a wonderful time of breakfast together with the aunty that came
- Thank God for my father-in-law fetching me to-and-fro to the car workshop, with nice workshop uncles to work with

Tuesday:

- Thank God for raising godly leaders to lead SG in Truelove.is
 - Thank God that someone is leading, and I could join and be part of the intercession for the next generation
 - Thank God for wonderful colleagues at work
 - Thank God that we got the confirmation listing done properly
 - Thank God that my evening schedule was cancelled so that I can rest

The above only has 3 days of thanksgivings. By the time I finished listing 7 days, I was very overwhelmed. Right there in my list, I see God at every juncture, walking with me through it all, in the most intimate way, because He knows the most intricate desires of my heart. I'm sharing with you my list vulnerably, because I was to illustrate how, at every juncture, every moment, things can go southward, but it didn't.

We are at war indeed, and it will take a seemingly long time. But take heart, because each and every day, we can live victoriously. Until our last breathe, like Joshua, let's keep on saying "as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord".

In the meantime, at each and every juncture, let's give thanks to God, because He is with us, sustaining us through all the small battles we face each day, until we have 'conquered' and be more and more like Jesus.

⇒ Try making your list for the past 7 days, and may God open your eyes to see how much God is actually involved in your life, and walking with you through all big and small battles...

⇒ Sing 7 times a day (see below)
