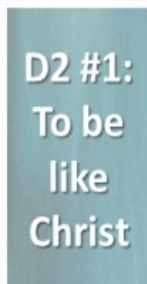
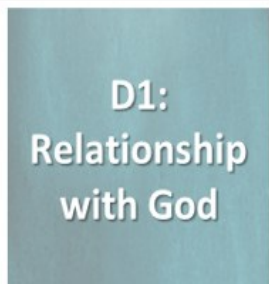

# DEVOTION FOR THE WEEK

## **Rewriting the Summary of my Life**

Three weeks ago, the day before Mother's Day, I visited my mother's niche at the columbarium. On one of the plaques at the columbarium was engraved the verse, "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith." (2 Timothy 4:7).

As the Apostle Paul looked back towards the end of his life, he could confidently say, "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith"

We don't have to wait until the end of our lives to take stock of our lives. In fact, as we approach the middle of the year, I feel this is a good point for us to take stock of our lives, count our blessings, and to make any necessary adjustments to re-align our lives.

The summary that the Apostle Paul gave as he reflected on his own life gives us key principles on how we can likewise align our life to live in a manner pleasing to God.

## **I have kept the faith**

Here Paul's statement can be read as "I have been faithful to what I have been entrusted with (The Gospel)" or "I have kept faith with my Master".

Firstly, all of us have been entrusted with a divine mandate on our life, with the appropriate resources to fulfill that God-given mandate. Have we been faithful to the charge that God has given us?

Secondly, and more importantly, have we been faithful to God, our Master? Do we trust Him unreservedly in ALL areas of our lives, during the good times, and the not-so-good times? Is God our first resource, or our last resort as we face the challenges of life?

### **I have fought the good fight**

This particular phase highlights the reality of spiritual warfare in our lives. As we walk with the Lord, we face enemies to our faith, namely, the devil, the world, and the flesh. Paul's admonition is for us "not to be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of our minds" (Romans 12:1-2). And as we talk about enemies, the greatest enemy may actually be within. We need to deal thoroughly with sin in our lives. As I reflected on my own life, the Lord showed me the wickedness of my own heart and how prone I am to fall into sin. If we are not careful, we can allow satan to have a foothold in our lives which eventually becomes a stronghold in our lives. In dealing with sin we can apply the "Remove & Replace" principle. We remove the things in our lives that would tempt us to sin, for example, watching Netflix, and seek to replace that same time slot with something else that's beneficial, i.e. reading a good book.

### **I have finished the race**

The analogy of finishing the race speaks of endurance and training. In ancient Greece, in order to enter a race, a participant must demonstrate proof that he has been in training for the race. And in order to win, he must endure, and run the race to the very end.

A wise mentor once said, "The secret to discipleship is that we don't TRY to be disciples, but rather we need to TRAIN to be disciples. Training is a necessary aspect in building the

stamina for endurance to finish the race of faith. All good athletes need the value of going back to the basics in training. Likewise, we need to go back to the basics of prayer, systematic Bible reading, scripture memorization, and devotional journaling in the course of training to be disciples.

As we reach the middle of 2022, let's us re-commit ourselves take stock of our lives, and re-align our lives so that we can live with confidence, with a view to fight the good fight, finish the race, and keep the faith!
