WORLD

Pray for the Philippines, which was recently struck by Typhoon Kalmaegi, causing severe flooding and destruction across the central and northern regions, and displacing over a million people. Pray for the protection of families in evacuation centres, and for swift and effective relief and rescue efforts. May the Lord grant wisdom, strength, and endurance to all rescue workers, and provide the necessary aid for those in need. May His peace prevail over the nation, bringing comfort, hope, and grace to all affected.

We continue to uphold Myanmar in prayer as conflict and humanitarian suffering persist. May the Lord provide for the people's daily needs including food, medicine and shelter. Pray that the nation's leaders will govern with compassion and justice, and work towards restoring stability and rebuild the economy so that the people may look forward to a better future. Pray also for the church in Myanmar, that believers and pastors will be kept safe and steadfast in faith. May the light of Christ shine brightly through them, and draw others to His love.

SINGAPORE

As Singapore reassesses its goal of achieving 30% food self-sufficiency, we ask for God's provision and that no one will go hungry. Pray that our leaders will find wise and equitable solutions for the nation's food security.

We also lift up the issue of rising online scams and the new laws enacted to combat them. Pray for protection, especially for the vulnerable, and that as a nation we may stand united against such crimes through vigilance, care, and looking out for one another.


