WORLD

We also pray that world leaders will treat the climate crisis with the seriousness it demands, taking practical and urgent action to address rising risks. We lift up vulnerable nations such as Jamaica, Cuba, and Tuvalu, which are deeply affected by climate threats. May they find strong partners, sufficient support, and lasting solutions that bring protection, resilience, and hope.

SINGAPORE

We lift up to the Lord those who are struggling with addiction to drugs, gambling, pornography, vaping, digital dependency or other harmful habits. May God grant them courage and resolve to break free from what holds them captive. We pray that they will not have to suffer in silence, but have ready access to help, counselling, and supportive communities that can walk with them on the road to recovery. May the grace of our Lord and His love draw them toward repentance, renewal, and the rebuilding of their lives.
