WORLD

Pray that world leaders will continue to work closely together to bring about an amicable and speedy resolution to the conflicts in the Middle East. Pray for the protection of the vulnerable and the preservation of lives, from the devastating effects of war. Pray that every nation will recognise the need to uphold the right of transit passage in straits used for international navigation and that such channels will remain open, secure and accessible to all. Pray that in the midst of escalating geopolitical tensions and uncertainties, the light of the gospel will continue to shine, bringing hope and salvation to many who are living in fear and in the shadow of death.

SINGAPORE

Pray for Prime Minister Lawrence Wong and our government as they continue in their tireless efforts to address the immediate impact of the US-Iran war on our nation. Pray for wisdom to take appropriate and effective measures to (i) secure essential energy supplies in order to maintain the generation of power, (ii) strengthen our economic resilience by helping businesses sustain production capacity, and (iii) provide financial support packages to companies and households to alleviate the impact of higher energy costs and inflation. Pray for insight and foresight as they also focus on long-term contingency plans to ensure energy security and supply chain continuity, prepare for prolonged disruptions arising from the damage to the Middle East energy infrastructure, and maintain national stability in the midst of on-going geopolitical uncertainties.
