Destiny Impact (DI) Youth Camp on 19-21 June

Pray that the camp kickstarts the development of a community with a strong sense of belonging and desire to know more about Him, and that campers will want to continue to gather regularly post-camp to explore or grow deeper in the faith. Pray that the Holy Spirit will show the unbelievers their need for a Saviour, and that by faith they will want to receive God's salvation.
