WORLD

Remember especially the elderly, the poor, outdoor workers, and all who are vulnerable to the effects of extreme temperatures. Ask the Lord, who rules over all creation, to have mercy and compassion on those who are suffering. Pray that He would bring relief and protection, and grant wisdom to governments and communities as they respond to these challenges. May those who are weary and afflicted find strength, comfort and hope in the Lord, and may many come to know our Lord Jesus Christ, who invites all who labour and are heavy laden to come to Him and find rest.

SINGAPORE

Pray for the Church in Singapore in light of recent findings showing a decline in the number of Christians, particularly among the younger generation. Ask the Lord to awaken us from complacency and lukewarmness, and to lead us in humble reflection and repentance where we have failed to faithfully pass on the faith to future generations. Pray that God gives us His heart for the lost, that we may see every soul as precious and deeply loved by Him. May He stir in us a renewed urgency to share the gospel, disciple the young, and strengthen one another in faith. As one Church united in Christ, may we seek out those who have drifted away, lovingly draw them home, and faithfully proclaim the hope and salvation found in our Lord Jesus Christ.

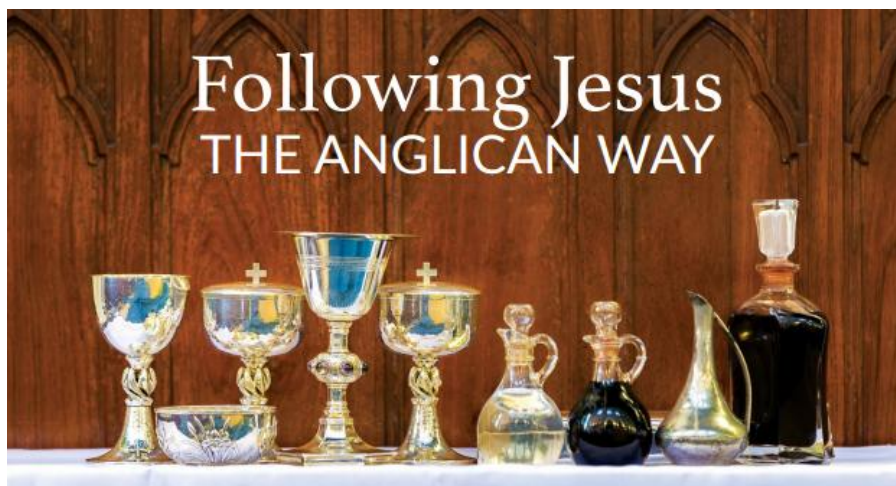
