PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS

WORLD

Pray that peace will prevail over violence and extremism, and that God will protect innocent civilians. May God grant wisdom to Pakistan's leaders as they uphold justice and restore stability to the nation.

SINGAPORE

Pray for those living with dementia, that God will surround them with His love and compassion, and that they would be treated with dignity, patience and care. Remember their families and caregivers, especially those who may feel weary or overwhelmed, asking God to strengthen them, give them wisdom and patience, and sustain them in the demands of daily care. Pray also for domestic helpers who are entrusted with caring for the elderly, that they will receive the training, guidance and support they need. May God give them compassion and understanding in their daily responsibilities, and move our society to show greater care and support for those living with dementia and the families who walk alongside them.

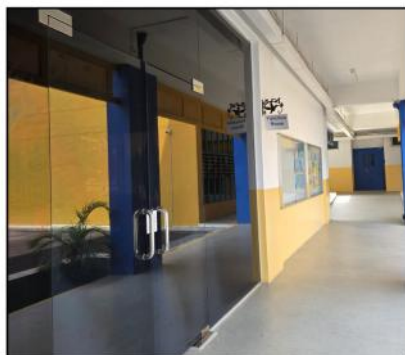
